- Entrants must be U.S. residents and 18 years of age or older. Offers to enter will be accepted ONLY by the mailing of a receipt to the entrant. Offers for which no valid return mail address is provided; tendered with a check which is returned unpaid or a credit or debit card charge which is declined; ~~or received by mail~~, or **not postmarked** by, or by fax after 5:00 pm EST on ~~May 4, 2010~~ **June 20, 2010** will NOT be accepted.
